3. Critically examine Weber's theory of Protestant Ethic and the Spirit of Capitalism.
4. Distinguish between Sex and Gender. Discuss the gender issues with suitable examples.

Section B

1. Write short notes on any three of the following (each note should not exceed 200 words):
 - a. Industrialisation and social change
 - b. Community power
 - c. The sacred and the profane
 - d. Ethos of science
2. What are the uses of Bogardus social distance scale and of Likert scale? Discuss.
3. In what way is the process of socialisation helpful in the development of personality? Explain with suitable examples.
4. Explain Melvin Tumin's critique related to the theory of social stratification.
